

ORDINANCE NO. 2022x06

TOWN OF BELVIDERE

WARREN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF NOT MORE THAN \$61,500 FROM THE CAPITAL FUND IN CONNECTION WITH THE COSTS ATTRIBUTABLE TO PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLE FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Belvidere wishes to appropriate the sum up to \$61,500 from the Combination of the American Rescue Plan and a USDA Grant in conjunction with the Purchase of a Police Vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Belvidere has been awarded \$268,056.17 under the American Rescue Plan and has also been awarded \$30,200.00 from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) –Community Facility Direct Grant Program

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Belvidere Town Council that:

1. There are funds available from the American Rescue Plan awarded along with a USDA Grant Awarded to the Town of Belvidere
2. There is hereby appropriated that sum of up to \$31,300 from the American Rescue Plan of which are currently in the Federal and State Grant Fund of the Town of Belvidere for the aforementioned purpose along with \$30,200 from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA)- Community Facility Direct Grant Program
3. There is no debt authorized by this ordinance.
4. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage following a public hearing to be conducted thereon and publication of notice of final passage with the requirements of the law.

NOTICE

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a regular meeting of the Belvidere Town Council held on November 14, 2022 and was read for the first time. This ordinance will be further considered for final adoption by the Belvidere Town Council at a meeting to be held on December 10, 2022 at Belvidere Town Hall, 691 Water Street, Belvidere, NJ at 7:00 P.M. or at any time and place to which said meeting may be adjourned. All interested persons will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning said ordinance at that time.
